



FLYING OUT OF NIGERIA? 7 THINGS TO KNOW



01

All passengers travelling OUT of Nigeria are advised to test for COVID-19 by PCR. It is recommended that the PCR test is done withing **72 – 96hrs** before boarding.



02

All intending passengers
are required to register
via the Nigerian
International Travel
Portal online:

A confirmation email will be sent to all intending passengers for their scheduled tests at the approved test centers once payment is confirmed





04

Passengers should present themselves at the testing center for COVID-19 PCR test sample collection 3 days before scheduled flight.



05

Post sample collection, passengers should proceed on a 3 days self-Isolation. During this time, they are to avoid physical interactions with friends, family, colleagues, and other members of the public (i. e. must observe strict physical and social distancing)



06

The test results should be ready within **24 – 48 hours** and the state Public Health Teams & Nigeria Center for Disease Control (NCDC) will be informed accordingly. In addition, the private laboratory would present the passenger with a copy of the test result. Please note that all test results would be validated at the airport and anyone found with a fake result may suffer consequences and would be treated as a criminal offence.

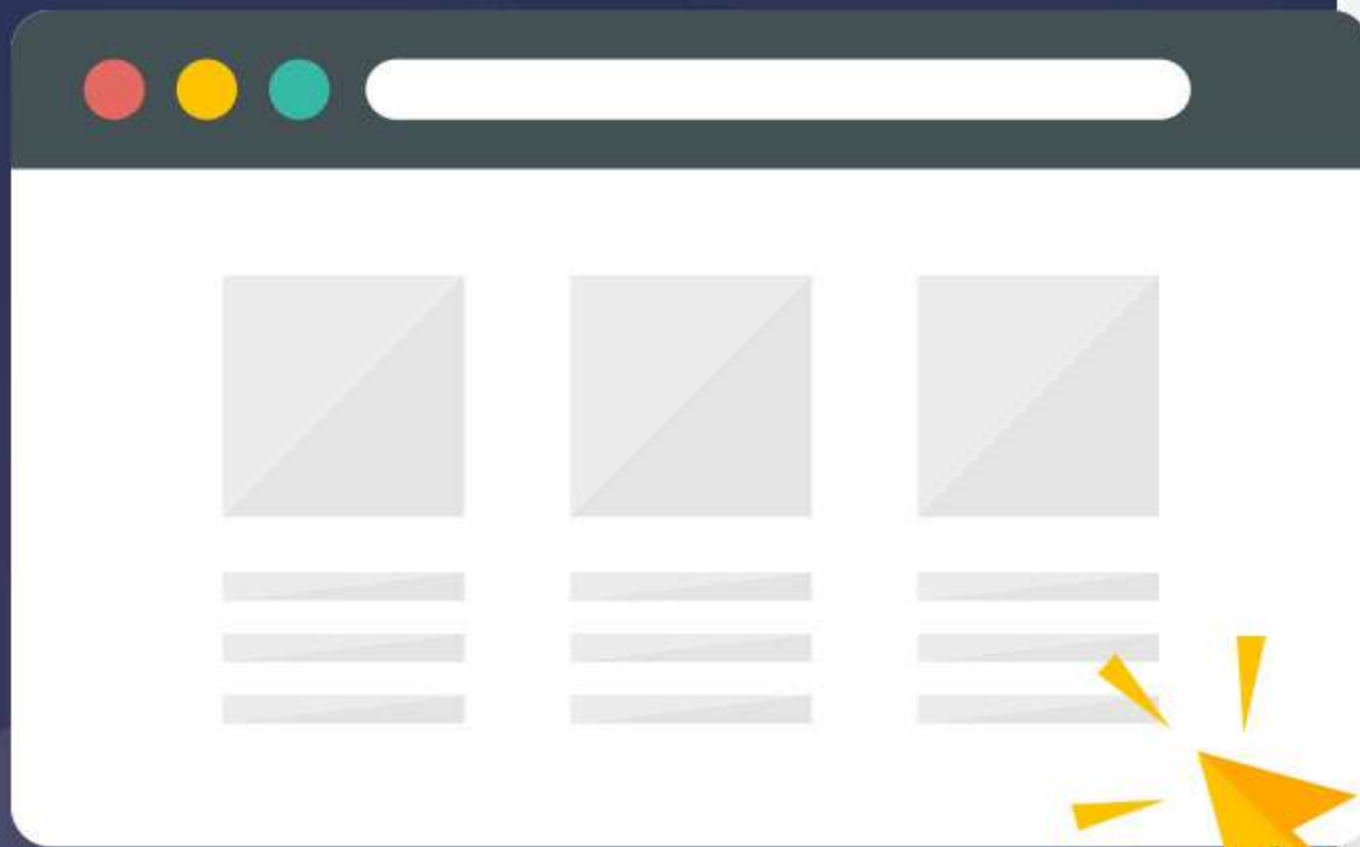

If negative, passengers can proceed to travel. However, if positive, they should isolate for 11 days after which, test will be repeated. If there are any symptoms during this period, please call **08000EKOMED** or **08000CORONA**. If outside Lagos, call the NCDC toll free number, **0800 970000 10**
